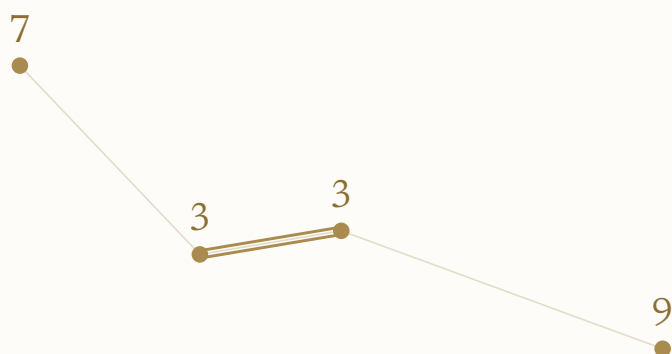

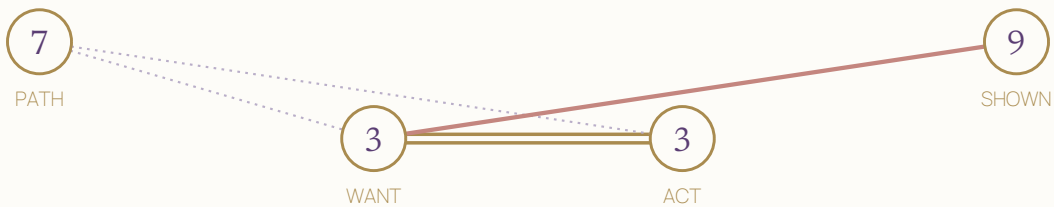

Your chart, mapped



bound = same number · slender = different methods · warm = natural allies

Three relationships shape this chart — the reading walks through them in order, each one a way your parts meet.

What your chart shows early

- ③ ③ If you catch yourself in connecting through play and talk — that's one way of loving showing up twice, not two problems.
- ⑦ ③ If you catch yourself in connecting through play and talk — that's two habits that live side by side, not a flaw.

The math, shown

Life Path: reduce day, month, and year separately, then add — masters 11, 22, 33 kept whole.

06 -> 6 · 11 -> 11 · 1988 -> 8 = Life Path 7

Soul Urge = vowel letters: I(9) + O(6) + A(1) + E(5) = 21 -> 3

Expression = all letters: W(5) + I(9) + L(3) + L(3) + O(6) + W(5) + H(8) + A(1) + R(9) + T(2) + L(3) + E(5) + Y(7) = 66 -> 3

Personality = consonant letters: W(5) + L(3) + L(3) + W(5) + H(8) + R(9) + T(2) + L(3) + Y(7) = 45 -> 9

Your Life Path, up close

Your Life Path is a 7. In CosmicShe's method, the Life Path is the path — your baseline way of moving through love, the way of loving the rest of the chart meets. A 7 moves through love by going quiet to process. It also carries understanding-first and opening slowly. At its steadiest, you take quiet, then come back and share. Under strain, the same way of loving can retreat so far the other is left guessing — not a flaw, the shadow side of a real strength. Hold the quiet method next to the name numbers as you read: the findings ahead are mainly about how it meets — agrees with, argues with, or reinforces — each of the other three.

The three name numbers

WHAT YOU WANT · SOUL URGE 3

In CosmicShe's method, the Soul Urge leads in love — what you most deeply want sets the reading's center of gravity. Your Soul Urge is a 3 — what you most deeply want. At its steadiest, you connect through talk and play. Against your 7 path it's a different method to translate.

HOW YOU ACT · EXPRESSION 3

Your Expression is a 3 — how you act and participate in love. At its steadiest, you connect through talk and play.

WHAT SHOWS FIRST · PERSONALITY 9

Your Personality is a 9 — what you show first / how you come across. It runs on giving without gripping; at its steadiest, you give freely without keeping score.

FINDING 1 · SOUL URGE 3 & EXPRESSION 3

3 3 *What you want and how you love speak one language.*

Why can 'just talking' feel like the whole relationship? Start with the plainest fact in this chart: the same 3 sits in your Soul Urge and Expression. Those are still different jobs, but both speak the same symbolic language: connecting through play and talk. There can be less distance between what you're reaching for and what you're showing. Secure, that's a gift — the two speak one language. Under pressure they can agree in the wrong direction, so heavier material keeps getting deferred. One small move: let one heavy thing into the conversation, and watch where the pressured side of connecting through play and talk shows up in both places.

This pair matters because it's the distance between wanting and doing: what you most deeply want from love, and how you actually behave inside it. When these two agree, you're easy to read; when they differ, loving you well takes a translation.

In your Soul Urge — what you most deeply want — that shows up as connecting through play and talk. In your Expression — how you act in love — it shows up as connecting through play and talk.

Closeness can be a lit-up conversation: the joke that lands, the story told well, the back-and-forth that makes an ordinary evening feel like the good part. Talking is the connecting.

At its steadiest, you connect through talk and play.

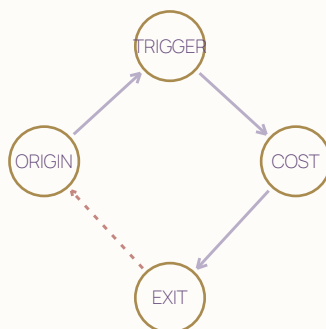
A conversation can tilt toward something that matters — and almost before you notice, a joke arrives to meet it. The room brightens, and the serious thing politely agrees to wait.

Because both jobs run on one method, there's no in-house counterweight — the strength doubles, and so does the blind spot. What this pair does well, it does effortlessly; what it avoids, it avoids in stereo.

Let one heavy thing into the conversation, and watch where the pressured side of connecting through play and talk shows up in both places — that's the move. In practice it's smaller than it sounds: just connecting through play and talk — the smallest real version of it, tried once in an ordinary moment rather than saved for a crisis. It won't go perfectly, and it doesn't need to — the point isn't balance overnight, it's one vote for the missing side.



Your pattern, decoded



Origin: Going quiet to process — that's how you tend to meet love, and it's where the pattern starts (your 7 path). Trigger: it surfaces when the wanting and the acting both run on connecting through play and talk. Cost: pushed too far, you can retreat so far the other is left guessing. Exit: let one heavy thing into the conversation, and watch where the pressured side of connecting through play and talk shows up in both places. The pattern isn't the whole chart — it's one part meeting the rest.

People meet your 9 first: you give freely without keeping score. What's less visible at first is you connect through talk and play — what you actually want once someone is past the first impression. And underneath the want sits your Life Path 7, going quiet to process: the quiet engine most people don't see at first. The gap between the surface and that engine makes for one possible misread — the first impression gets taken for the whole story. One sentence can do a lot of the explaining: "If my warmth feels general, ask me something only you would ask — the specific answer is yours."

Where you are this year

This is an excerpt. Willow's full reading runs 12 pages. Still ahead in hers:

Finding Two · One difference, two places — why a genuinely good evening can be followed by a quiet she didn't plan.

Finding Three · An easy alliance — why warmth is what people meet first, while the particular closeness takes its time.

When love feels steady — and when pressure rises · Her pattern, decoded · The year she's standing in · Working with her chart.

Every page of it was computed from her name and birth date. Yours would be computed from yours.
